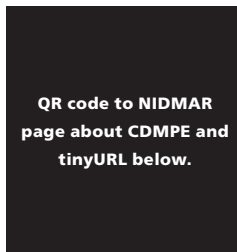

As a CDMP-E, you demonstrate the ability to:

- Lead disability management programs and teams
- Develop and oversee organizational policy and strategy
- Provide executive-level leadership and oversight
- Strengthen organizational performance and workforce sustainability

## Eligibility and Assessment

CDMP-E is designed for experienced CDMP professionals who have progressed into executive leadership roles.

Applicants must demonstrate:

- Current CDMP designation
- Minimum 5 years as a CDMP
- Minimum 2 years in senior leadership/supervisory role
- Experience supervising professionals and managing programs
- Experience in policy development, strategic oversight and organizational leadership

Assessment is conducted through an executive-level evaluation process, including structured interviews and a written assignment.
